

Colorado Horsemen's Day At The Capitol

Information You Can Use As You Support the Colorado Horse Industry.

Please go to the web site; www.votesmart.org to find your Colorado Representative and Senator. (All you need is your zip code) We will have list by district, but please find out your district.

Date & Time: Tuesday, January 20th. The meeting will start at 9:00 am. Given the large number of attendees expected, it would be advisable to arrive a few minutes early to allow ample time to sign-in, get a name tag and pick-up handouts.

Directions: The Capitol is located at 200 East Colfax Ave in Denver . This is on the edge of downtown, between Grant (west side) & Sherman (east side). The public entrance is on the north and handicap entry on the south.

Parking: There are ample parking lots in the area. The cost runs from \$6.00 to \$12.00 a day. Of course car pooling reduces the cost by spreading the cost.

Public Transportation: There are many 'Park & Rides' in the Denver area. For example, horsemen coming from the south can use the Park & Ride at I-25 & Broadway. If you want to use RTD, check the website for complete information; www.rtd-denver.com and click on "Trip Planner."

Early Arrivals: There is a small coffee shop and tables in the north end of the basement.

Meeting Room: We will meet in Room 356 on the third floor. The elevators are located off the rotunda. Please, no food or drinks in the meeting room.

Dress: Business casual/Western attire is appropriate. I would knock the muck off the boots and remove the spurs, but no need to over dress.
